Why Chilewich?

Durability and longevity. Designed with both beauty and function in mind, Chilewich woven rugs retain their distinctive colors and rich textures over many years of use, indoors and outdoors.

A sleek, stay-put backing. Chilewich rugs are cushioned with a commercial-grade latex backing that prevents slipping and curling. At just 0.14 inch in thickness, the mats fit easily under most doors.

Easy maintenance. Sweep or vacuum to remove loose dirt or wipe clean with soap, water, and a soft sponge or cloth. It is recommended to flip the mat occasionally to allow the backing and surface beneath it to dry.

Protection against mold and mildew. Strengthened by Microban™, these mats resist stain- and odor-causing microbial growth. This protection works continuously for the lifetime of the product.

Placement

- Best suited for dry surfaces.
- Made with advanced color technology to prevent fading. However, like all textiles, mats may fade if exposed to direct sunlight for long periods of time.
- Latex backing may tear if placed on a rough surface. This will not affect the woven face of the mat or its performance, but a rug pad can be used to prevent tears.

Care

- Occasionally turn mat over to air mat backing out
 - If saturated with liquid, mat backing will absorb the moisture, yet excess may migrate to the surface the mat is on.
- When moving or storing, roll up the mat with the woven fabric facing outwards
- Avoid placing objects made of rubber (including rubber castors) on your mat, as it may discolor the mat.

Cleaning

- In case of moss or mold (which may grow on dirt or debris on or below mat), clean with a bleach or hydrogen peroxide solution and wipe with cloth.
- To deep clean, hand-wash mat with water and light detergent. Air dry completely before placing on the floor.
- Do not machine wash.
